


approx. 14 feet 8 inches wide x 14 feet 8 inches long

BEFORE YOU START PAINTING: Please completely read the General Instructions & prepare your surfaces as recommended.



STEP 1:


Align the edges of **STENCIL A** and **STENCIL B** and tape them together.

Layout your **STENCIL** in your desired location.




STEP 2: Quadrant 1

Paint the borders of both stencils. **DO NOT**PAINT THE NUMBERS. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL A** and **STENCIL B**. Fill in the gaps so your **STENCIL** is complete.




STEP 3: Quadrant 2

Align the border of **STENCIL A** over the painted pavement. Paint the borders of both stencils. **DO NOT PAINT THE NUMBERS**. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL A** and **STENCIL B**. Fill in the gaps so your **STENCIL** is complete.




STEP 4: Quadrant 3

Align the borders of **STENCIL A** and **STENCIL B** over the painted pavement. Paint the borders of both stencils. **DO NOT PAINT THE NUMBERS**. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL A** and **STENCIL B**. Fill in the gaps so your **STENCIL** is complete.



STEP 5: Quadrant 4

Align the borders of **STENCIL A** and **STENCIL B** over the painted pavement. Paint the borders of both stencils. **DO NOT PAINT THE NUMBERS**. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL A** and **STENCIL B**. Fill in the gaps so your **STENCIL** is complete.



STEP 6: BORDER

YOU SUCCEEDED!

You finished painting the border of Four Square Large. Your painted Four Square Large border should look like the image to the left.



STEP 7: PAINT QUADRANTS

Now paint the four quadrants. Your painted Four Square Large should look like the image to the left. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application.



STEP 8: PAINT NUMBER 1

Now align **STENCIL A** over quadrant 1. **PAINT ONLY NUMBER 1**. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL A**.



STEP 9: PAINT NUMBER 2

Align **STENCIL B** over quadrant 2. **PAINT ONLY NUMBER 2**. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL B**.



STEP 10: PAINT NUMBER 3

Align **STENCIL A** over quadrant 3. **PAINT ONLY NUMBER 3**. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL A**.




STEP 11: PAINT NUMBER 4

Align **STENCIL B** over quadrant 4. **PAINT ONLY NUMBER 4**. Repeat 1-2 more times to achieve desired vividness, drying after each application. Then remove **STENCIL B**.
